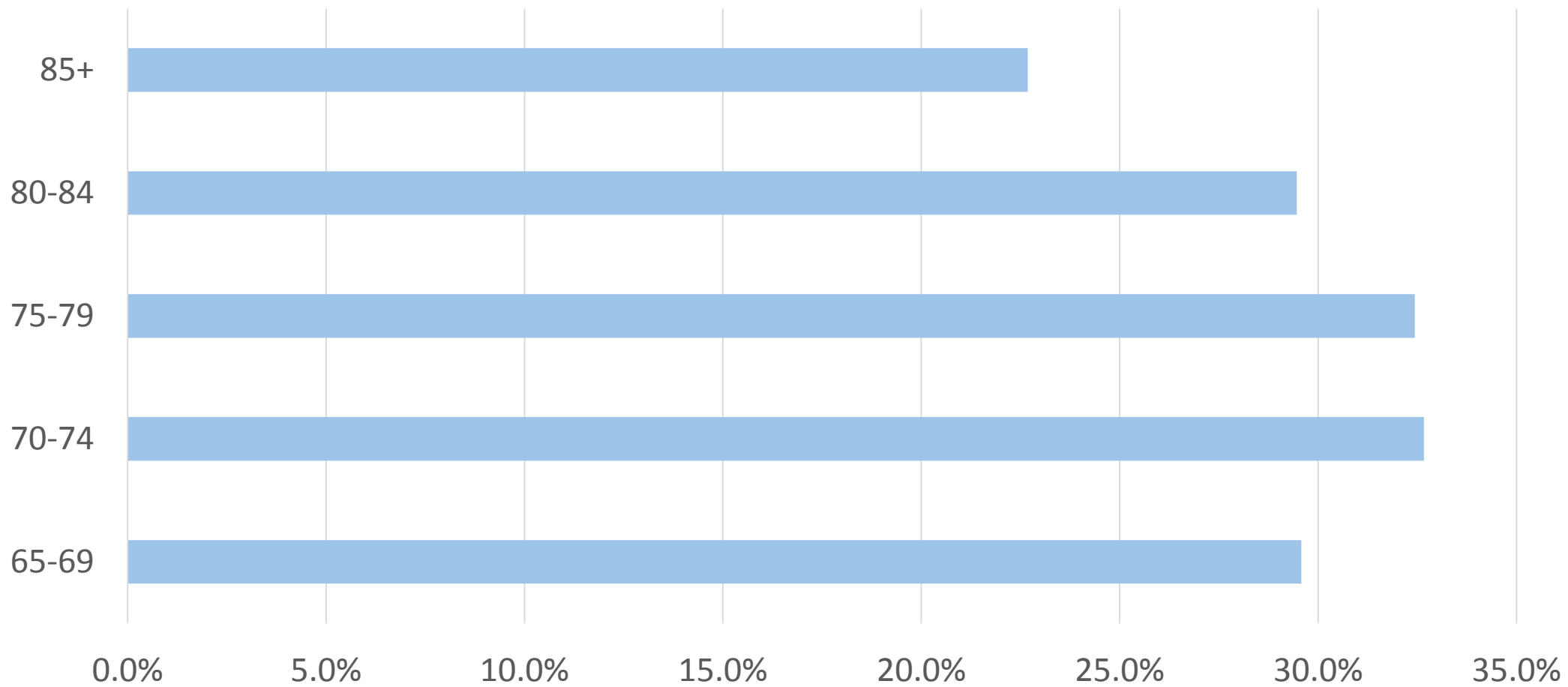


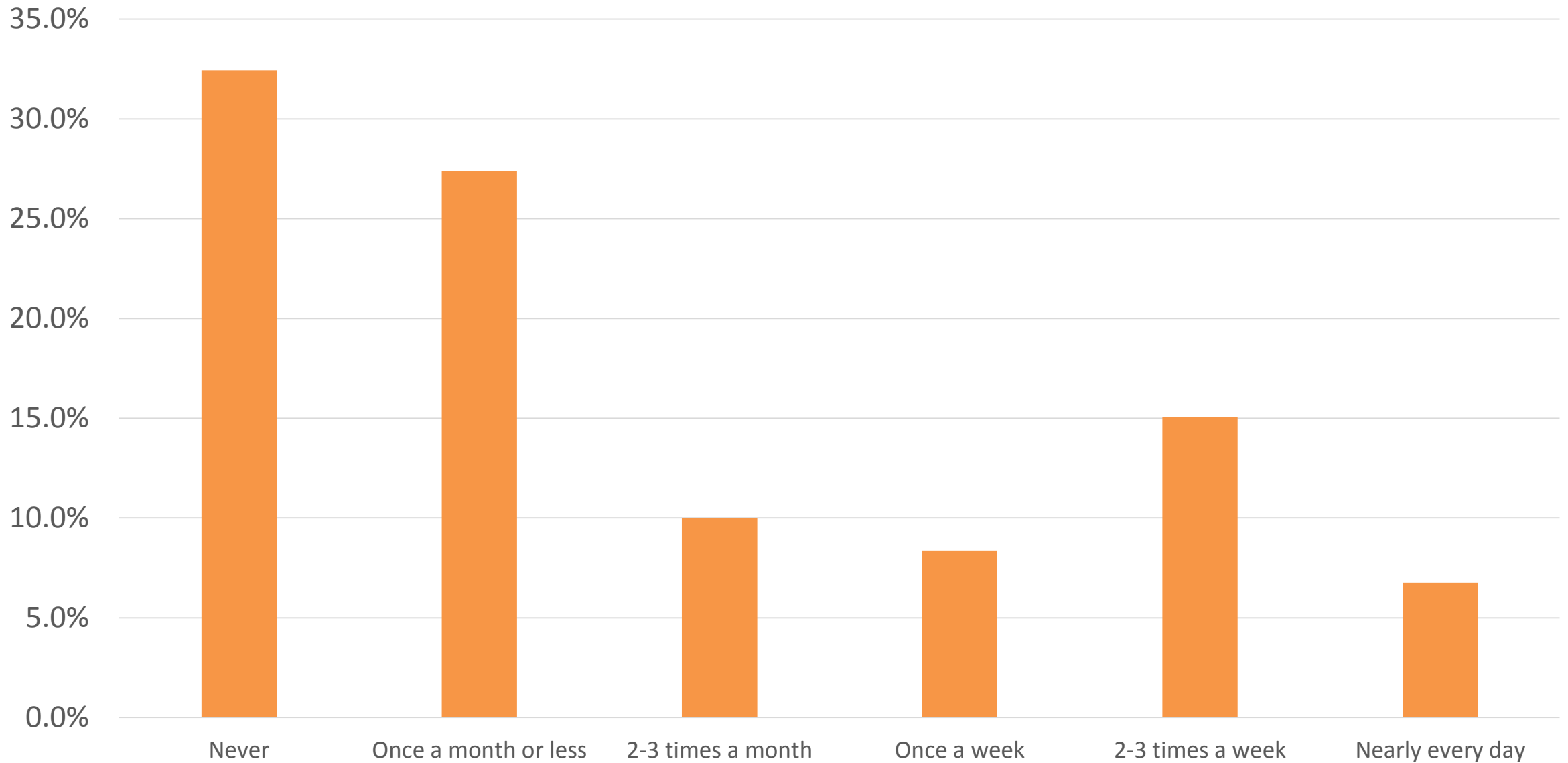

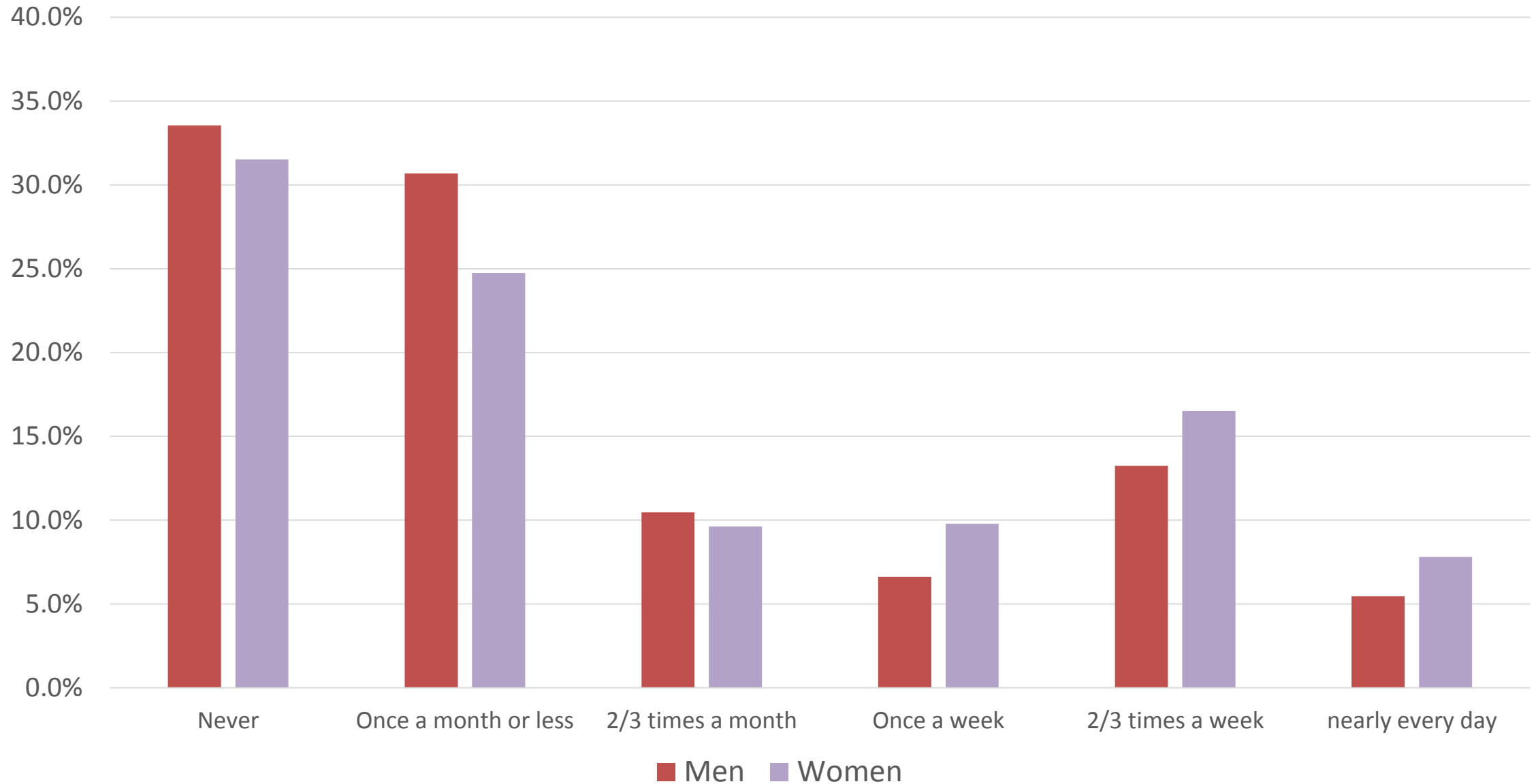
Proportion using public transport at least once a week



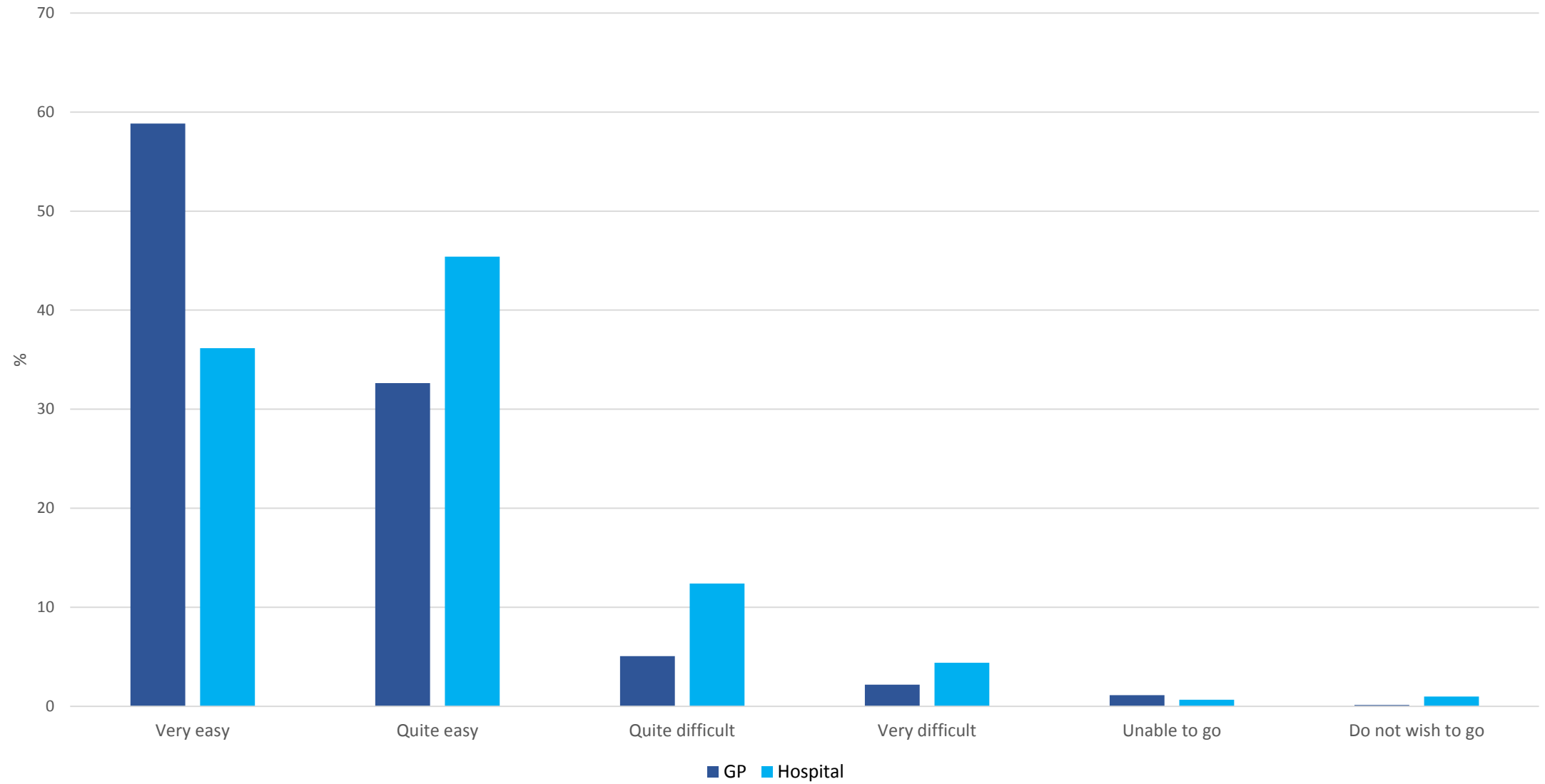
Frequency of use of public transport by people aged over 65

Ease of medical visits for the over 65s



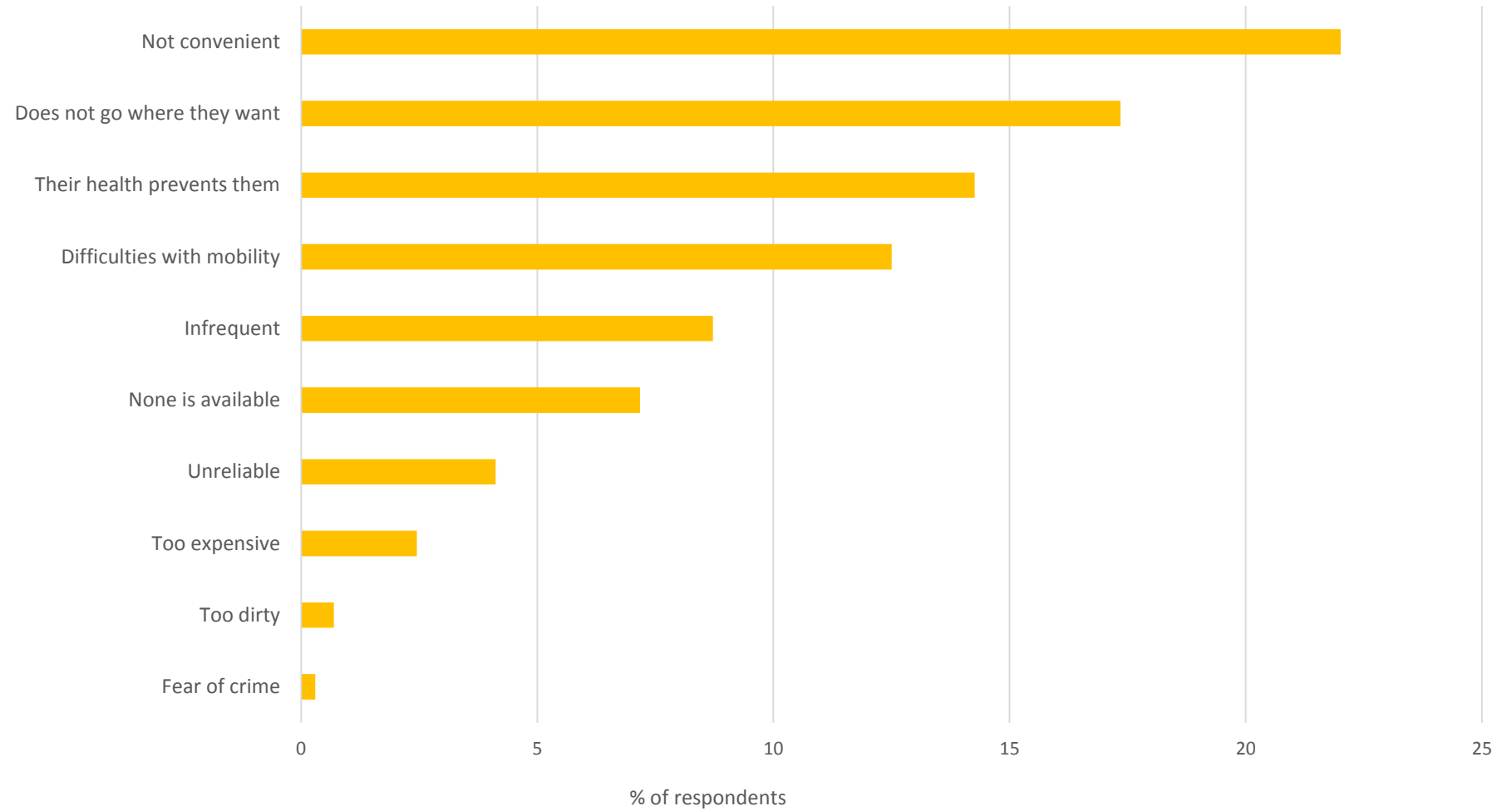

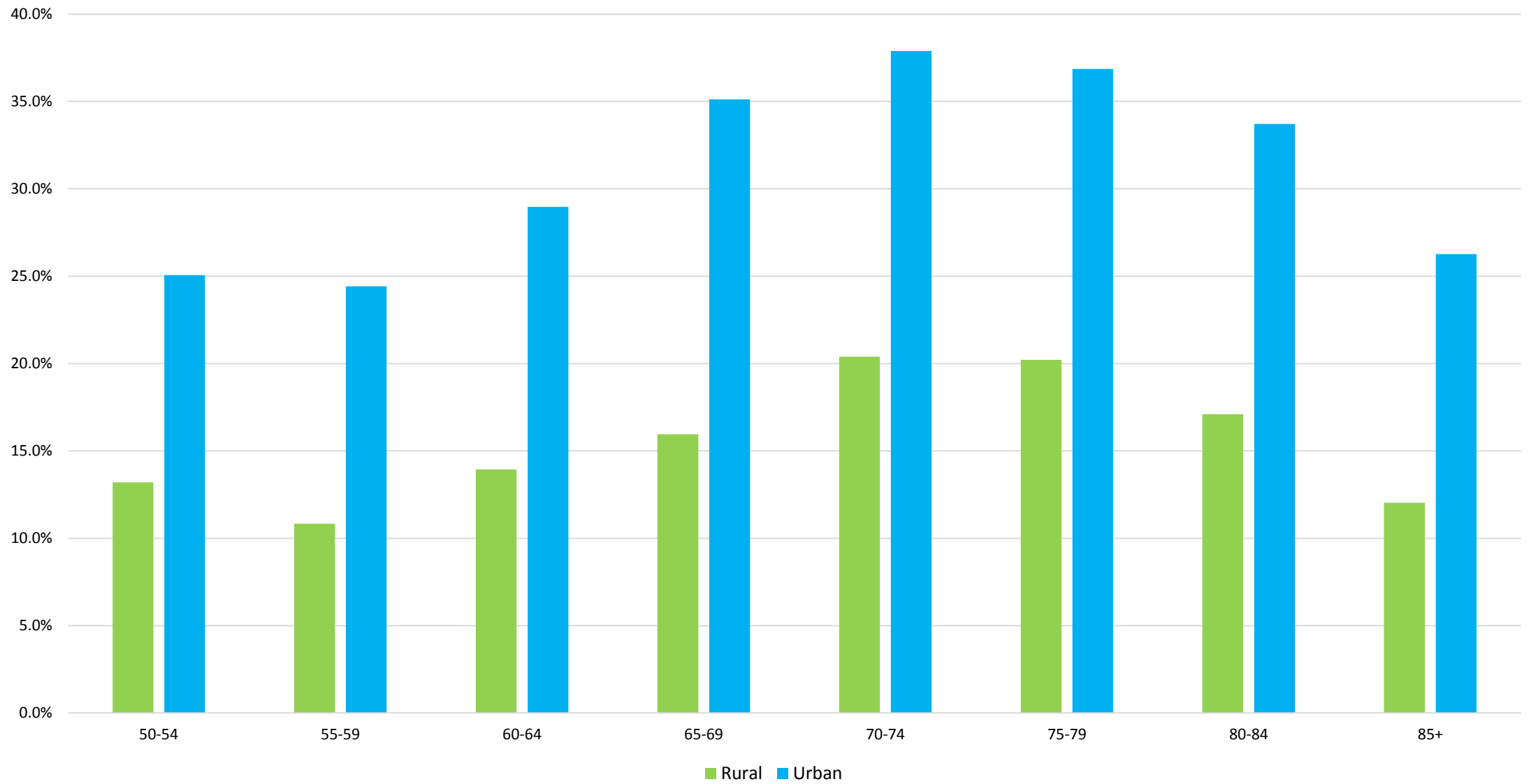
