

What it means to be a Future Years Forum Committee member:

- Attendance at four Future Years forum committee meetings a year. Meetings run from 11.30 - 3.30 p.m. The first part of the meeting is an informative presentation.
- Sub-regional representatives give a report at these meetings detailing what has been happening in their area to promote the needs and expectations of older people.
- Members bring information back to the forum, particularly if they have attended a conference.
- Members may wish to sit on a working party of the Age Action Alliance. These meet quarterly and are held in London. Members are expected to report back to the rest of the committee.
- Members are required on task and finish groups to ensure the actions in our workplan are completed.
- Members are required to cascade information, especially the Friday News, to older people in their region.
- Future Years respond to consultations regularly and members need to present the views of older people from their region into these consultations.
- Communicating issues through various means is important and we ask members to write articles for distribution.
- Members can expect their travel and subsistence expenses to be reimbursed by Future Years in a timely fashion.
